## SIGHT Protocol

Clostridioides difficile (C. difficile)

- Suspect C. difficile infection for any patient who develops diarrhoea with no clear cause, particularly those who have recently taken antibiotics or immunosuppressive therapy in last 12 weeks.
  - Isolate symptomatic patients in a single room with their own bathroom. Inform Infection Prevention and Control Professional.
    - Gloves and apron/gown are worn for all patient and environmental contact as per standard & contact precautions.
      - Hand hygiene is performed as per the 5 Moments using alcohol-based hand rub or soap and water.
        - **Test** the stool for *C. difficile* toxin and other pathogens as clinically required.
